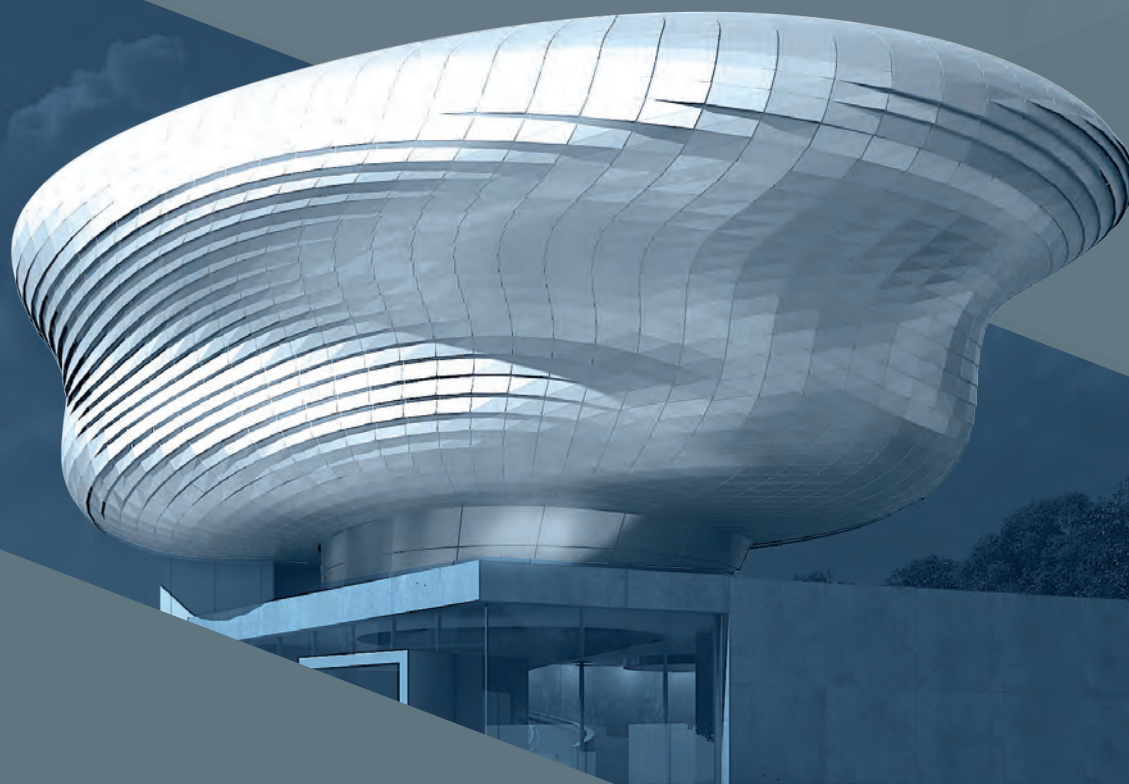

The PANEUM bears the signature of Prof. Wolf D. Prix, CEO of COOP HIMMELB(L)AU, one of the most renowned architecture firms in the world. The self-supporting “cloud ship” is perched upon the concrete base, inviting the viewer to reflect. The distinctive, organic shape is visible from afar and is home to the extensive backdrin art and culture collection. The free-form construction is made almost entirely of Austrian wood, which makes the PANEUM not only one of the most sustainable, but above all one of the most innovative buildings in the world.
